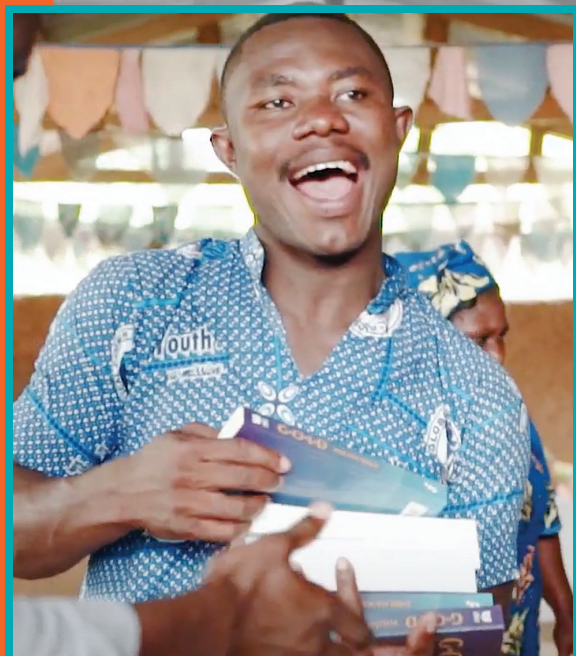

"When I was a kid, my parents broke up. I ran away from my father and his new wife, and I was homeless for the next four years," he reveals. "With the help of a good friend, I found Jesus and was baptized. As a youth leader, I got to take part in *Project Philip*." Richard has a passion for youth and is eager to share the Word of God with the children and teenagers in his community. He beams, "After I completed the training, God put the children and youth from the nearby village of Oseikrom on my heart."

Richard's enthusiasm for the Gospel is contagious, and the youth he mentors are just as eager as he is to share it with their friends and family members. One young man, Jeffrey, puts it this way, "I want to mature in Christ and follow His Word."

And a young girl named Blessing was thrilled to get a Bible of her very own. Grinning broadly, she says, "I like having my own Bible and now I am able to read it on a regular basis!" The joy these young people felt having access to the Word of God touched the hearts of everyone who was present to witness them receive their Bibles.
